Lantern Lodge



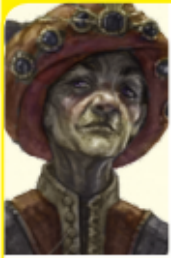
Secret Agent,

Osirion



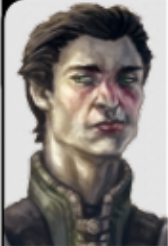
Servant of the Prince,

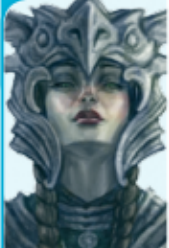
Listen up soldier!

Noble Guardian,

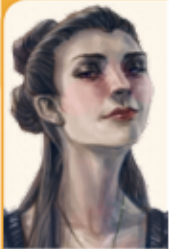
